Keet Seel, Betatakin and Inscription House are three of the most famed prehistoric dwellings in the whole of the Southwest.

They are grouped together in Navajo National Monumeni, just south of the Utah border is Arizona's great Navajo Indian teser-

In these time-buried remains of ancient apartment houses archaet ologist and layman alike can see evidences of a great civilization that for some as yet unknown rea. son ceased to be.

Even the archaeologists, who look upon Keet Seel, Betatakin and Inscription House as treasure trove, of information about folk of ह long-gone day, cannot answer the question of what became of them.
These people the went awas? They left no Written record. Modern conjecture about them is built on the now-crumbling physical things that they left behind.

Identified As Spanish
Archaeologists have identified this inscription as having been placed by one of the Spanish explorers who roamed the Southwest in the 16th and 17th centuries, but who were not supposed, until this was found, to have gone north of Grand Canyon.

Betaizkin and Inscription House were discovered more than 30 years so by Dr. Cummings. Keet Seel is irst knotovn to have been seen in $\delta 94$ by Richard Wetherill, an Indian trader.
