DESCRIPTION STRING DRESS WORN BY YOUNG SINAGUA GIRLS. WAIST-BAND/BELT IS COMPOSED OF APPROXIMATELY 32 Z-SPUN, S-TWIST, 2 PLY STRANDS OF DARK BROWN COTTON RANGING FROM 0.6 TO 1.1 MM IN DIAMETER. THE BELT PORTION EMERGES FROM THE FRINGE AS A SINGLE BUNDLE, TIED TOGETHER AT ONE POINT, 6 CM FROM THE EDGE OF THE FRINGE, BY A SIMPLE KNOT CONSISTING OF TWO STRANDS OF THE SAME CONSTRUCTION AND MATERIAL AS THE FRINGE, WITH THE FOUR ENDS LEFT HANGING AS A SEPERATE FRINGE. THE MAIN FRINGE IS A SEPERATE CONSTRUCTION, TIED TOGETHER AT TOP AND BOTTOM WITH THE STRANDS LEFT LOOSE IN THE CENTER. THE APPROXIMATE 32 STRANDS ARE
