PHIL GEIB IDENTIFIED THE POINT AS CLOVIS, 5/19/2005. HE STATED THAT THE PATINA IS SIMILAR TO A POINT THAT HAD BEEN LAYING AROUND FOR AS LONG AS A CLOVIS POINT WOULD HAVE BEEN. THE TIP WAS A VERY OLD BREAK, PROBABLY AS OLD AS THE PUEBLO OCCUPATION. SOME KNICKS ON THE SIDES COULD BE A THOUSAND YEARS OLD, OTHERS ARE MORE RECENT.
